College Competitions (2025 Feb. 20 & 21)

GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. Only students from university-affiliated colleges and film institutes (govt.) can participate in the competitions.
2. Registration is compulsory for participating in any event.
3. **College identity cards are must for registration.**
4. Online registration through our site www.sjccmelange.com can be used, but to complete the process, payment of registration fees at the counter and collecting the badge is mandatory.
5. Registration must be done at least 1 hour before the commencement of each event.
6. Registration fees (without food) and prizes for each event is mentioned along with the rules.
7. One accompanying teacher or student as college team manager is permitted per college.
8. No accommodation facilities will be provided.
9. It is the duty of each participant to enquire about the time schedule of the event (www.sjccmelange.com) and must report on time.
10. Participants and the team manager must carry their college identity cards and badges given at the time of registration along with them and must produce the same on demand.
11. Regarding the competitions and results the decisions of the judges will be final. And regarding the organization and arrangements, the decision of the organizing committee will be final.
12. The committee has the right to make any changes in the schedule/ venue /guidelines if circumstances demand.
13. Any preliminary test may be conducted according to the decisions of the event coordinator, where necessary.
14. If the number of entries / participants for any event is not more than five, certificates will be awarded only on basis of the grades obtained for the performances. The organising committee has the right to decide over the prize money in such cases.
15. Banners, Hoardings, Flexes etc. are not allowed inside the campus without prior permission.
16. Misbehaviours will be dealt strictly.
17. No gyrate movement, catcalls/ howling are tolerated. Any improper/ unruly behaviour or violation of college rules may result in scrapping of points/ disqualification of team/ cancellation of prizes.
18. Smoking and consumption of alcohol/ drugs etc. are strictly prohibited.

19. Any participant or team found under influence of alcohol or drugs will be disqualified and not allowed to participate in any of the events.
20. Rules of each event have to be strictly followed. For any details or clarification regarding the rules contact the event in-charge of each event between 9:30 AM & 5:00 PM.
21. Taking photos inside the campus is strictly prohibited.
22. The artworks created by the participants will not be returned back and the organizers (SJCC) reserve the right to use the same.

1. 72 ORA

1. '72 ORA' - is the official name of 72 hours film making.
2. The competition will begin from **Feb 17th 02:00 PM** and ends on **Feb 20th – 02:00 PM**.
3. The duration of the final out will be 3 minutes.
4. Only works submitted within the deadline will be considered for the competition.
5. Online registration is mandatory for participating and registration fees should be remitted before the time of final submission
6. Final submission of the film must be in .mpeg format and the rushes should be produced if demanded by the jury.
7. Final Submission should be accompanied with a printed (or written) document containing the synopsis of the film, details and roles of team members and technical details.
8. The final films should be submitted on February 20th 05:30 PM in person at SJCC competition venue along with geo-tagged photos of production in various intervals.
9. The film must be appropriate for a general audience, avoiding offensive, defamatory, or inappropriate content, including hate speech, nudity, or excessive violence.
10. Any violation of the rules, including plagiarism, copyright infringement, or failure to adhere to ethical guidelines, will lead to disqualification.
11. College ID cards of all team members are mandatory for final submission.
12. The theme will be provided by Feb 17th 02: 00 PM (through www.sjccmelange.com)
13. The decision of the jury will be final.
14. The short films by the participants will not be returned back and the organizers reserve the right to use the same.

3. MiniScape

1. '**MiniScape**' - is the official name of 'Scene recreation using Miniature'.
2. Individual and team entries are allowed, with a maximum of 3 members per team.
3. Registration & College ID cards of all team members are mandatory.
4. The competition will begin from **Feb 20th 10:30 AM** and ends by **05:30 PM**.
5. The scene to be recreated will be provided on the spot. The scene can be from a movie, book, historical event, or a fictional setting.
6. The set must be a scaled-down replica of the assigned scene.
7. The **maximum base size** allowed: **3ft x 3ft** and Height restrictions: **3ft max**.
8. Teams can use **cardboard, foam board, clay, resin, wood, paper, fabric and upcycled materials**.
9. **No store-bought pre-made models or kits** (e.g., pre-built dollhouses, action figures) can be used.
10. Use of **LED lights, basic electronic circuits, and motorized parts** is permitted if relevant.
11. Teams will have **8 hours** to complete their set.
12. Teams must bring their own tools. **Power tools are NOT allowed** for safety reasons.
13. Final Submission should be accompanied with a printed (or written) document containing the floorplan, draft drawing and material details.
14. Only works submitted within the deadline will be considered for the competition.
15. The decision of the jury will be final.
16. The miniatures created by the participants will not be returned back and the organizers reserve the right to use the same.

1. This will be conducted as group event (group of two).
2. Participants can use any type of digital cameras (should bring their own equipment).
3. The competition will begin at **10:00 AM** and ends by **04:30 PM**.
4. It is mandatory to have 2 bytes (30 sec max in total), 1 standup and voice over.
5. Editing of footage can be done, but digital manipulation of any kind is not allowed.
6. Use of background music is permitted but not mandatory.
7. The final out must be 2 minutes in duration.
8. A team can submit only one entry.
9. Final out should be in MP4 format.
10. The news report must be appropriate for a general audience, avoiding offensive, defamatory, or inappropriate content, including hate speech, nudity, or excessive violence.

11. Any violation of the rules, including plagiarism, copyright infringement, or failure to adhere to ethical guidelines, will lead to disqualification.
12. The other rules if any will be given by the judges on time.

5. Content, Fluency, Spontaneity and Sense of Humour of the contestants will be evaluated
6. Other rules if any will be given by the judges on time.

1. This will be conducted as an individual event.
2. Two contestants can participate from a college.
3. The competition will be conducted in the college lab.
4. Personal systems will not be allowed.
5. Only one entry will be allowed for a participant.
6. Participant should create A4 size using any one of the graphics editing tools or software and the file format extension should be .psd or .jpeg or pdf with at least 300 DPI resolution.
7. Each design must have a version in colour and in black & white
8. The subject for the designing will be announced at the venue.
9. Participant should not include any violent or immoral content in the logo
10. Duration of the competition will be 2 hrs.
11. Other rules if any will be given by the judges on time.

 - Choreo-Magic round - the participants selected from the first round will be qualified for this round.
3. Time limit allowed for the music in choreo-magic (Round 2) should not exceed 10 minutes.

4. The judging of the performances will be based on their choreography, synchronisation, costume and overall effect.
5. The judges' decision will be final.

8. FACE PAINTING

1. A team of two students can participate from a college. (Either two boys or two girls)
2. Each competitor must bring all of his / her own face painting supplies including paints, brushes, rinse water for brushes, water container, sponges, sponge-tipped applicators and other tools and supplies necessary to complete the task.
3. It is the responsibility of the competitor to bring the model. Models need not be registered for the competition.
4. Contestants should not use photos or drawings to refer to while painting.
5. All designs will be painted free-hand.
6. Only professional makeup (cosmetics) and paint products made specifically for the skin should be used. Products may be applied wet or dry. (Contestants must avoid the use of acrylic paints and other commercial paints including tempera paint, craft paint, textile paint, airbrush paint etc. for this event).
7. Use only skin-safe adhesives & adhesive removers.
8. Loose and Pressed Powders, including Shimmer Powders can be used.
9. Airbrush system is not allowed.
10. Use of stencils or stamps of any kind are not allowed.
11. Don't use masks over any part of the face.
12. Prosthetic pieces that are glued or taped to the face (i.e. fake cuts, scars, warts, noses, etc.), false eyelashes, special effects contact lenses, novelty eyeglasses or sunglasses are not allowed.
13. Duration of the competition will be 2 hrs.
14. The other rules if any will be given by the judges on time.

2. Individual and team entries are allowed, with a maximum of 5 members per team.
3. Registration & College ID cards of all team members are mandatory.
4. The competition will begin from **Feb 20th 10:00 AM** and ends by **03:00 PM**.
5. The ad must adhere to the given theme and should not exceed 30 seconds, including any credits.
6. Only works submitted within the deadline will be considered for the competition.
7. All visuals, scripts, and audio must be original. If external content (music, sound effects) is used, proper licensing and credits must be provided.
8. Submissions must be in MP4 or MOV format with a minimum resolution of 1080p and the rushes should be produced if demanded by the jury.
9. Final Submission should be accompanied with a printed (or written) document containing the synopsis of the film, details and roles of team members and technical details.
10. The ad must be appropriate for a general audience, avoiding offensive, defamatory, or inappropriate content, including hate speech, nudity, or excessive violence.
11. Any violation of the rules, including plagiarism, copyright infringement, or failure to adhere to ethical guidelines, will lead to disqualification.
12. The final films should be submitted by **Feb 20th 04:00 PM** in person at SJCC competition venue along with geo-tagged photos of production in various intervals.
13. The decision of the jury will be final.

6. Drums will be provided but rest of the instruments are to be brought
7. Technical support will be provided from our college

14. TREASURE HUNT

1. Team Size: 3–8 members per team, multi-stage hunt with clues leading to the final treasure.
2. Teams must complete the hunt within the overall deadline.
3. Teams will receive their first clue at the starting point., Each clue leads to the next location or challenge.
4. Teams may have to solve riddles, complete mini-games, or perform tasks to obtain the next clue.
5. The first team to find the final treasure wins.
6. Teams cannot use the internet, phones, or outsiders to solve clues, Clues must not be destroyed, hidden, or altered, Teams must not enter restricted or off-limits areas.
7. Teams must not interfere with other teams' progress (e.g., stealing clues).
8. All team members must stay together. Splitting up is not allowed.
9. Disqualification Criteria: Using unauthorized help (internet, bystanders, other teams), Tampering with clues or treasure, violating campus rules or damaging property, failing to complete a challenge within the given time.
10. Teams must check in 30 minutes before the event starts.
11. The decision of the committee will be final.

15. VALORANT

1. Each team must consist of 5 players (+1 substitute, optional).
2. Registration will be closed by **Feb. 18th 10:30 AM**. Contact co-ordinators for registration.
3. Match Format:
 - Group Stage matches:

- i. All group stage matches will be conducted online.
 - ii. Top teams from each group proceed to knockout rounds.
 - Knockout Rounds: Quarterfinals & Semifinals: Best of table, Finals: Winners from Semifinals
4. Match Rules:
- Pause Limit: Each team gets one tactical timeout (60 seconds) per half.
 - Technical Pause: Allowed only for technical issues (max 5 minutes).
 - FPS Lock: All matches will have FPS locked at 144.
 - No External Assistance: No coaching or external help during matches.
5. Use of hacks, macros, or third-party software will result in immediate disqualification.
6. Abusive language, hate speech, or disrespectful behaviour will lead to warnings or bans.
7. If a player disconnects, the match will continue unless a technical pause is requested.
8. Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Rules:
- Players must bring their own laptops, chargers, and peripherals (mouse, keyboard, headset, etc.).
 - Ensure your device meets minimum system requirements for Valorant.
 - The tournament organizers will not provide backup devices if yours fails.
 - Internet connection will be provided, but players are responsible for their own settings and game readiness.
9. Teams must check in 30 minutes before their match.
10. The decision of the committee will be final.

16. eFOOTBALL Team Tournament

1. General Information:
- Game: eFootball PES Mobile (latest version)
 - Platform: Mobile (Android/iOS)
 - Format: 2v2 or 3v3 (Based on participation)
 - Mode: Online Match Lobby / Friendly Match
2. Bring Your Own Device (BYOD): Players must bring their own smartphones/tablets and chargers.
3. Team Requirements:
- Each team must have 2 or 3 players (depending on the format).
 - Players can only register for one team.
4. Match Format
- Group Stage matches - Top teams from each group advance to knockout rounds.
 - Knockout Rounds :
 - Quarterfinals & Semifinals: Best of knockouts
 - Finals: Winners of Semifinals
 - Match Settings:
 - Match Time: 7 minutes per match
 - Extra Time & Penalties: Enabled for knockout rounds
 - Stadium: Random or Neutral
 - Weather & Time: Default

5. Match Rules

- Players can use only their own custom teams (no default teams).
- Connectivity Issues: If a player disconnects due to network issues, the match continues unless the issue happens within the first 2 minutes (then it may be restarted).
- Device Malfunction: No rematch will be granted if a player's device lags or crashes.
- Fair Play: Exploiting game bugs/glitches or using unauthorized software will result in immediate disqualification.
- Harassment, abusive language, or unsportsmanlike conduct will lead to warnings or bans.
- No Coaching or External Help: Only registered team members can participate.

6. Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Rules:

- Players must bring their own mobile devices, chargers, and headphones.
- Ensure the device has sufficient battery and stable internet.
- The tournament organizers will not provide backup devices.

7. Teams must check in 30 minutes before their match.

8. The decision of the committee will be final.
