COLLEGE COMPETITIONS AND GUIDELINES

30th November to 2nd December 2022

GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. The competitions are open to students from all colleges affiliated to Indian universities.
2. Registration is mandatory for participating in any event.
3. Online registration is available through our website, www.sjccmelange.com; however, in order to complete the process, the participant must pay the registration fees and collect their badge in person from the registration counters located at the venue.
4. Registration must be done at least 1 hour before the start of each event.
5. Registration fees (without food) and prize money for each competition are mentioned, along with the rules given in the following pages.
6. One accompanying teacher or student, as college team manager is permitted per college.
7. Participants and the team manager must carry their **college identity cards** and participation badges, given at the time of registration, and must produce them on demand.
8. Accommodation facilities will not be provided by the organisers.
9. Each participant has a responsibility to check our website, www.sjccmelange.com, for information regarding the schedule and venue of the events, and they are required to be on time.
10. The judges' decisions are definitive in terms of competitions and results. The administration and arrangements will be decided by the organising committee, and their decision is final.
11. The committee has the right to make any changes in the schedule, venue, or guidelines if circumstances demand.
12. Any preliminary test may be conducted according to the decisions of the event coordinator, where necessary.
13. If the number of entries or participants for any event is not more than three, certificates and points will be awarded only on the basis of the grades obtained for the performances. In such cases, the organising committee has the right to decide on the prize money.
14. Without prior approval, banners, hoardings, flexes, and other similar items are not permitted inside the venue.
15. Misbehaviour will be dealt with strictly.
16. No gyrating, catcalling, or howling is permitted. Any improper or disruptive behaviour or violation of college regulations may result in the cancellation of prizes, the team's disqualification, or the loss of points.
17. Smoking and the consumption of alcohol, drugs, etc. are strictly prohibited. Participants violating this rule will be disqualified and restricted from the events.
18. Rules of each event have to be strictly followed. For any details or clarification regarding the rules contact the event in-charge of each event between 9:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
19. Taking photos inside the campus is strictly prohibited.
20. The artworks created by the participants will not be returned back and the organisers (SJCC) reserve the right to use the same.

EVENTS, RULES AND PRIZES

RJ/VJ HUNT

(1st PRIZE: ₹3,000/- and 2nd PRIZE: ₹2,000/-)

1. “**RJ/VJ Hunt**” is an individual event.
2. The competition will be conducted in multiple rounds.
3. The presentation should be based on the topic given by the judges on spot.
4. Spontaneity, clarity and accuracy of the contestants will be evaluated along with presentation and conversation skills.
5. Other rules if any will be given by the judges on time.

BLUNT

(BEST TEAM - ₹5,000/- and BEST SPEAKER - ₹2,000/-)

1. “**Blunt**” is the official name for the debate competition.
2. The medium of the competition is English.
3. There are two speakers on each debate team. One speaker will endorse the debate statement and the other speaker will retort the earlier assertion.
4. Structure of the competition
 - a. Speaker 1 (Proposition) - 2.5 mins
 - b. Speaker 2 (Opposition) - 2.5 mins
 - c. Speaker 1 (Proposition) - 2.5 mins
 - d. Speaker 2 (Opposition) - 2.5 mins
 - e. Questions from the judges - 2.0 mins
5. Total time - 12 mins (each debate).
6. The topic for the debate will be provided 24 hours before the competition through our website, www.sjccmelange.com.
7. There will be a warning bell at the end of two minutes.
8. The speaker has to conclude the speech at the end of two and a half minutes.
9. There will be a moderator and timekeeper.
10. The judges have the authority to determine who the Best Team and the Best Speaker will be.
11. Criteria for Judging
 - a. Evidence and Facts - 25%
 - b. Presentation - 30%
 - c. Interpellation - 30%
 - d. Rebuttal - 15%

LOGO DESIGNING (DIGITAL)**(1st PRIZE: ₹3,000/- and 2nd PRIZE: ₹2,000/-)**

1. “**Logo designing**” is an individual event.
2. Two contestants can participate from a college.
3. The competition will be conducted in the college lab.
4. Personal systems and pen/graphic tablets will not be allowed.
5. Each participant is only allowed to submit one entry.
6. Participants should create A4-sized images with at least 300 DPI resolution using any of the graphics editing software, and the file format extension should be .png, .jpeg, or .pdf.
7. Each design must have a version in colour and in black and white.
8. The subject of the design will be announced at the venue.
9. The participant should not include any violent or immoral content in the logo.
10. The duration of the competition will be 2 hours.
11. Other rules, if any, will be given by the judges on time.

1. “**Peritia**” is the official name for the animation short film contest.
2. The theme of the short film will be “**Hope**”.
3. Participants can use any animation technique.
4. The duration of the submitted video should not exceed 2 minutes.
5. The videos are to be submitted on the date of the competition (30th November 2022) before 1:30 PM.
6. The works submitted within the deadline will only be considered for the competition.
7. Previously published/broadcasted works are not eligible for submission.

LIHOK GRAPHICA**(1st PRIZE: ₹4,000/- and 2nd PRIZE: ₹3,000/-)**

1. “**Lihok Graphica**” is the official name for the motion graphics contest.
2. The theme of the motion graphics will be “Increase of knowledge and the lack of empathy towards the world”.
3. The duration of the submitted video should not exceed 30 seconds.
4. The videos must be submitted before 1:30 p.m. on November 30, 2022.
5. The works submitted within the deadline will only be considered for the competition.
6. Previously published/broadcasted works are not eligible for submission.

STANDUP COMEDY**(1st PRIZE: ₹3,000/- and 2nd PRIZE: ₹2,000/-)**

1. “Standup comedy” is an individual event.
2. The time limit for the event is 3 to 5 minutes.
3. The content of the presentation should be decent and should be appropriate for the audience.
4. This interesting competition is based on presentation and conversation skills.
5. The content, fluency, spontaneity, and sense of humour of the contestants will be evaluated.
6. Other rules if any will be given by the judges on time.

FACE PAINTING**(1st PRIZE: ₹3,000/- and 2nd PRIZE: ₹2,000/-)**

1. A team of two students from a college can participate. (Either two boys or two girls).
2. Each competitor must bring all of his or her own face painting supplies, including paints, brushes, rinse water for brushes, a water container, sponges, sponge-tipped applicators, and other tools and supplies necessary to complete the task.
3. It is the responsibility of the competitor to bring the model. Models need not register for the competition.
4. All designs should be painted free-hand, no photos or drawings can be referred to.
5. Only professional makeup (cosmetics) and paint products made specifically for the skin should be used. Products may be applied wet or dry. (Contestants must avoid the use of acrylic paints and other commercial paints including tempera paint, craft paint, textile paint, airbrush paint etc. for this event).
6. Use only skin-safe adhesives and adhesive removers.
7. Loose and Pressed Powders, including Shimmer Powders can be used.
8. Airbrush system is not allowed.
9. Use of stencils or stamps of any kind are not allowed.
10. Don't use masks over any part of the face.
11. Prosthetic pieces that are glued or taped to the face (i.e. fake cuts, scars, warts, noses, etc.), false eyelashes, special effects contact lenses, novelty eyeglasses or sunglasses are not allowed.
12. Duration of the competition will be 2 hours.
13. The other rules, if any, will be given by the judges on time.

1. Any number of students can participate from a college.
2. Usage of cheat codes is not permitted and will lead to disqualification.
3. Game modes can be changed only if both the players are willing to play.
4. Other rules if any will be given by the coordinator on the spot.
5. The entry fee is ₹30/- for each player, it is a two player game.
6. The winner wins ₹50/- from a match.
7. The winner can play up to three games and have a chance to win ₹100.
8. A player who has played once can only play after 3 matches. (depending on the number of players waiting).

5. The final round consists of clues, each one leading to the next clue. The team which finds the treasure first, wins.
6. Organisers are free to make changes which will be informed prior to competition.

2. The duration of this contest will be 3 minutes. After 2 minutes the first bell will go off.
3. Negative marking will be there if participants exceed the time limit.
4. The participant can imitate any actor/actress and politicians from the Tamil and Malayalam industry.
5. The visuals of the performance must be handed over to the coordinators before November 28, any submissions after that will not be considered.
6. The decision of the judges will be final.

3. Participants can use any type of digital SLR cameras (should bring their own equipment).
4. Theme will be provided on the spot.
5. Digital manipulation of any kind is not allowed.
6. Duration of the competition will be 3 hrs.
7. A participant can submit up to 3 photographs in digital format (JPEG).
8. Other rules, if any, will be given by the judges on time.

1. The event is an open theme-based solo dance competition.
2. The event consists of basically two rounds
 - a. Self-Portrait round. A song will be played to the contestants and they have to perform a dance based on the given song. Duration should be 3 minutes.
 - b. Choreo-Magic round- the participants selected from the first round will be qualified for this round.
3. Time limit allowed for the music in choreo-magic (Round 2) should not exceed 10 minutes.
4. The judging of the performances will be based on their choreography, synchronisation, costume and overall effect.
5. The judges' decision will be final.

2. The competition will begin at 10:00 a.m. on November 28th and end at 10:00 a.m. on December 1st.
3. The film shouldn't last longer than three minutes.
4. Only works submitted within the deadline will be considered for the competition.
5. Online registration is mandatory for participating and registration fees should be remitted before the time of final submission.
6. Final submission of the film must be in .mpeg format and the rushes should be produced if demanded by the jury.
7. Final Submission should be accompanied with a printed (or written) document containing the synopsis of the film, details and roles of team members and technical details.
8. The final films must be submitted in person at the SJCC competition venue on December 1st at 12:30 p.m., along with geo-tagged photos of production taken at various intervals.

9. College ID cards of all team members are mandatory for final submission. The theme will be provided on November 28th at 09:30 a.m. (through www.sjccmelange.com)
10. The decision of the jury will be final.
11. The short films by the participants will not be returned back and the organisers reserve the right to use the same.

2. One team per college can participate.
3. A team can have a maximum 20 members (Including participants and coordinators).
4. Time limit for each team will be 10 minutes (Including setup and the performance both).
5. Team should report before 12:00 pm & the program will start by 3:30 PM.
6. Vulgarity is strictly prohibited. Any form of obscenity will lead to debarring the team from the contest.
7. Use of cigarettes, alcohol and any unfair means is strictly prohibited.
8. Theme selection is open to the team.
9. All costumes are permitted, which maintain decency including original costumes and fashion designs. We promote professionally made garments.
10. A green room will be provided for grooming.
11. Teams should carry their tracks in pen drive and should be submitted in advance.
12. Teams will be judged on costumes, theme, walking style and attitude.
13. Registration should be made early, spot registration is not encouraged.
14. Teams have to bring their own props.
15. Exceeding the time limit will result in negative marking.
16. Controversial, political or religious themes will be debarred from participation.
